### **Policy – breach of player code of conduct**

KBH Brumbies requires that all members adhere to the various Hockey Victoria (HV) Codes of Behaviour that can be found at: <http://membership.hockeyvictoria.org.au/Membership-Policies/Codes-of-Behaviour>. In particular, our Club will not tolerate abuse towards umpires or other officials.

Breaches of these Codes by players at any level may result in disciplinary proceedings. Should an incident report be submitted to HV, it will be up to HV to determine whether a player should attend a tribunal hearing.

The Committee has also determined that any player who receives a red card in a match shall be automatically suspended for one match. This is consistent with current HV rules that apply to Premier League and Vic League 1 games. The player has a right of appeal against this suspension.

In addition to this suspension, the Committee, upon receipt of a report on the incident that resulted in the red card, may decide to take additional disciplinary action in accordance with the Rules of our Club.

Team managers/captains are required to advise the Secretary of any red card with 24 hours of the incident.
