Juniors playing seniors selection policy amendment – Feb20

Background

As a club, we want to work closely with young players and ensure they get the best opportunities to develop. We have created this with multiple coaching and learning opportunities. We feel juniors are very important to our future, and strongly encourage players to play with their peers in a KBH team, and play seniors when they are ready.

Club Objectives:

- To prioritise senior team playing opportunities for junior playing members of KBH in preference to players who elect to play juniors at a competing club.
- To ensure time and resources spent developing junior players is maintained within the Brumbies playing group as much as possible
- To provide a playing and team environment that will allow every player to enjoy their hockey and play to their full potential
- To grow our player membership through the successful transition from juniors, while retaining and attracting new players

Amended policy

- Any player who plays juniors at a club other than KBH will be ineligible for selection into an elite KBH teams (defined as Mens or Womens PL and PLR, and the top Pennant side). Additionally, the player will not be eligible play in any other KBH senior team on a regular basis where it may lead to a lost opportunity for a junior player from KBH.
- Players may be exempted from this policy if the committee determines that KBH is not offering the relevant grade for the player in that season
- Junior players, not playing juniors at KBH, are required to prioritise KBH senior playing and training commitments at all times.
